Present: Supervisor Frank Johnson, Treasurer Bonnie Hayward, Clerk Christine Saddler, Trustee Vugteveen and Trustee Travis Bergman
Also present: Attorney Ron Bultje and seven members of the public.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Supervisor Johnson gave the invocation.

Vugteveen made a motion supported by Bergman to approve the minutes of the July 14, 2021 meeting. Motion carried.

Bergman made a motion supported by Vugteveen to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Ottawa County Commissioner Greg DeJong said that recently two of the K-9 dogs for the Sheriff's Office were retired due to ill health. A donor has stepped forward to pay for two new K-9s. He also said that a new ordinance was passed by the County restricting drone usage in the area of County Parks without permission.

Vugteveen made a motion supported by Johnson to select Horizon Bank as our primary banking institution. Roll call vote was held with all members present voting yes. Motion carried.

Vugteveen made a motion supported by Bergman to approve Depository Resolution No. 2021-08-12 designating the approved financial institutions for the Township. Roll call vote was held with all members present voting yes. Motion carried

Discussion was held regarding a request from residents of Crockery Township to consider holding another public hearing on expanding the slow no-wake zone on the Grand River to the East of Dick's landing. No action was taken.

Hayward made a motion supported by Saddler to approve the PA 116 applications from H. Walcott Family Farms LLC. Application F and application G. Roll call vote was held with all members present voting yes. Motion carried

Discussion was held regarding potential candidates for the open Planning Commission position.

Saddler made a motion supported by Johnson to approve the quote from Nutrien Ag Solutions for two applications of roundup at the Cemetery South property for a cost of \$618.55. Roll call vote was taken with all members present voting yes. Motion carried.

Hayward made a motion supported by Vugteveen to authorize Supervisor Johnson to send a letter to the Ottawa County Road Commission saying that he has been authorized by the board to request that a stop sign or a traffic light be installed at the corner of 144th Ave. and Mercury Drive when the non-motorized path is extended to that intersection. Input from the Treasurer and Clerk is to be obtained before sending. Motion carried.

Public comment was given by Chris Fox regarding issues she has had with people letting her fox out, and Dennis Berens with concerns over an unauthorized campground on Limberlost.

Hayward relayed information gathered regarding NOCH's policy on patient transport to the hospital, that it is up to the paramedic on scene in consultation with the hospital to determine to best location to transport the patient to, factoring in their condition and hospital status, which isn't always known by first responders.

Vugteveen made a motion supported by Bergman to pay the bills. Motion carried.

Reports were given on NORA, Park, Ambulance Oversight, Fire and Zoning. Reports are on file.

Vugteveen made a motion supported by Bergman to adjourn the meeting at 8:44 pm. Motion carried.
