

Minutes of the Regular Meeting
Robinson Township Board of Trustees
November 10, 2021 at 7:00 pm

Present: Supervisor Frank Johnson, Treasurer Bonnie Hayward, Clerk Christine Saddler and Trustee Travis Vugteveen

Absent: Trustee Travis Bergman

Also present: Attorney Ron Bultje and nine members of the public

The meeting was opened at 7:04 pm

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Supervisor Johnson gave the invocation.

Vugteveen made a motion supported by Hayward to approve the minutes from the October 13, 2021 meeting. Motion carried.

Johnson made a motion supported by Vugteveen to approve the agenda with the deletion of Greg DeJong, Chris VanHekken and planning commission member appointment. Motion carried.

Supervisor Johnson gave his opening remarks

Vugteveen made a motion supported by Hayward to purchase three Enduro minute books including paper from ElectionSource at a cost of \$207.40 each plus shipping. Roll call vote was held with all members present voting yes. Bergman absent. Motion carried.

Vugteveen made a motion supported by Hayward to adopt the Robinson Township Federal Procurement Conflict of Interest Policy setting the value limit of nominal gifts to be \$100. Roll call vote was held with all members present voting yes. Bergman absent. Motion carried.

Vugteveen made a motion supported by Johnson to approve the agreement for temporary housing with Anne Veach as modified. Roll call vote was held with all members present voting yes. Bergman absent. Motion carried.

Saddler made a motion supported by Hayward to approve MTPP Grant Application Resolution; Resolution No. 2021-11-14 to support applying for a grant to cover costs of installation of a security camera in the Township Hall parking lot. Roll call vote was held with all members present voting yes. Bergman absent. Motion carried.

Discussion was held regarding the options for the properties that did not sell at the foreclosure auction.

Discussion was held regarding ARPA funding. It was the consensus of the Board that the Treasurer could check with the auditor regarding revenue loss estimations.

Public comment: resident of Limberlost questioned if there were any updates into investigation of a possible unapproved campground being developed on Limberlost.

Mick Bricker shared information on progress of redistricting process.

Vugteveen made a motion supported by Hayward to pay the bills. Motion carried.

Treasurer: tax bills are at printer, balancing done with Clerk. Library: Community Foundation Grant will be earmarked for a drop box to be installed at the Township Hall. The current director will be retiring. NORA is considering a millage. Park: closed for the winter as of December 1st. Ambulance: short staffed resulting in long response times. Fire report given.

Motion was made by Vugteveen and supported by Hayward to adjourn the meeting at 8:28 pm. Motion carried.
