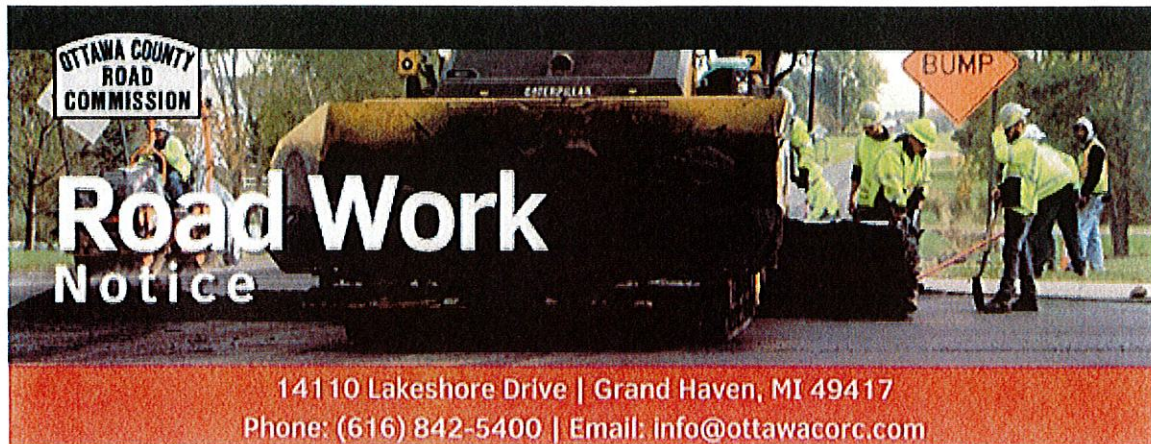

WHY: Boardwalk Work

BACKGROUND: Beginning Monday, April 1, 2024, Green St. between 128th Ave. and 144th Ave. in Robinson Twp. will be closed permitted boardwalk work. It is estimated that the road will reopen June 1, 2024.

This is a permitted project.

TRAFFIC IMPACT: A detour will consist of 144th Ave., Lincoln St., 128th Ave.
